The scholarships were designed to honor those who, in founding Theodore Gordon Flyfishers, fostered a tradition of educating people about environmentally responsible philosophies.

This year, the Founders Fund Committee selected one recipient. Kristen Tam graduated from UCLA with a degree in environmental science and is a master's student at the Yale School of Environment. Her research there studies the effects of applying manure as fertilizer on small-to-medium-sized dairy farms in the Northeast, concentrating on reducing both emissions of greenhouse gasses and runoff into freshwater bodies.

Each year as we introduce our scholar, the Founders Fund Society also honors an established, exemplary environmental leader. This year, we honor the Long Island Flyrodders, the first time that we have given that award to another organization. The Long Island Flyroddersis a fly-fishing club founded in 1985 that is devoted to the conservation of Long Island's cold-water fisheries and to the stewardship of the land. It focuses on building an angling and conservation community with its membership and outreach. The club offers outings that include river cleanups and assists other organizations to help promote land and water conservation efforts.
